### Ecumenical Vacation Bible School Offering

This year children and youth from our congregations will learn about kids in other parts of the world who live and work on family farms and villages and schools *where there is no electricity*.

Our offering will go toward the purchase of Luci Lights, inflatable solar-powered lanterns that can be used by kids who care for livestock, read to their siblings, and draw water in early morning or evening.
