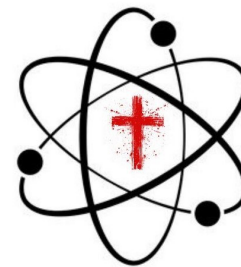
Today's Radio Broadcast and the bulletins are sponsored by Zion Members and Friends. Thank you to all who give to this ministry.
