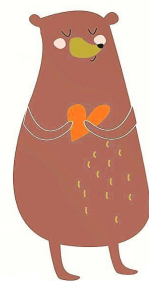
Announcements—October 6, 2024

We were blessed with wonderful music, great food, and joyful fellowship.



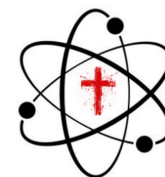
